More news on the "tank tops" at the next meeting.



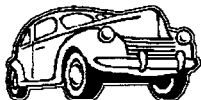
